DISTRICT COURTS amidst COVID-19 for The Willow's 3-County Service Area:

The Kansas Supreme Court has ordered that District Courts are to cease all business except for emergency operations until further order. Emergency operations mainly include: Temporary Protection From Abuse and Stalking Orders, First Appearances/Bond Hearings after an arrest, some Juvenile Detention and Child In Need of Care Hearings, Care and Treatment Commitments, Orders of Isolation or Quarantine, plus other miscellaneous operations. Additionally, all Probation/Court Services appointments are to occur by telephone only.
